

# Transportation Improvements – Florida at Work

## County Road 214 Improvements

### Resurfacing and Adding Paved Shoulders – Clay County



The road will be improved from C.R. 315C to S.R. 100.

## Project Summary

County Road 214 will be resurfaced and widened to provide a two-foot paved shoulder on both sides of the road. To accommodate the widening of the pavement, five drainage pipes that run under the roadway will be extended to meet current safety standards.

**Limits:** County Road 214 in Keystone Heights from State Road 100 to County Road 315 (6.5 miles)

**Lane closures:** One lane in either direction will be closed Monday through Friday between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. Lane closures will be limited to two miles in length. No nighttime work is anticipated at this time.

**Other impacts:** Mailboxes will be removed and relocated.

**Paving Impacts:** Expected to begin within three to four weeks of start of project (approximately March 8)

**Contractor:** APAC-Southeast of Jacksonville is the main contractor hired by FDOT. Many other subcontractors will be doing construction work on the project for APAC-Southeast.

**Inspection:** KCCS Inc., is a consultant engineering inspection firm hired by the FDOT to oversee the construction work on a daily basis.

**Funded by:** American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (federal economic stimulus funding)

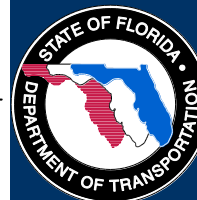
