

ADMINISTRATIVE SUBCOMMITTEE REPORT

JANUARY 18, 1994

The Administrative Sub-Committee has met on the second Tuesdays in the months of November, December and January. During this time, we have been asked to review two other concerns beyond the original task of reviewing the role of the Financial Officer, Elected Vs Appointed Manager and Firing County Employees without Cause. The two citizen's requests have been brought to closure by the sub-committee with the following recommendations to the full Charter Review Committee.

A) The concern of the environment and the pollution of the waterways in the county is, indeed, one of which each of us share. However, the subcommittee, upon research quickly realized that this concern did not fall in the scope of our review. (See attached letter) It is recommended that the full committee endorse the letter as it was written.

B) The issue of the 911 consolidation has been pulled from our agenda. The Sheriff indicated that he and the Safety Director felt such a consolidation could occur internally.

C) Firing Without Cause-After complete review, and input from the county attorney, the sub-committee has the following recommendation for the full Charter Review Commission. (See attached)
