

This is three (30 Separate motions:

That the Charter Review Committee place the following items on the agenda for the public hearings to be held on proposed revisions and amendments to Clay County Charter.

Motion: No. 1

That the Clay County Board of Commissioner Districts be changed from at large to single member districts whereby; each Commissioner or candidate for a position or seat representing a district would only be elected by the voters residing within the district he/she resided. Further that each county commissioner or candidate must be a resident of the district, maintain and reside within that district for the duration of their term of office when elected. Should any commissioner move from his district or fail to maintain a full time residency within the district from/by then the Board of County Commissioner within thirty (30) days of so finding declare the seat vacant and cause a special election to be held in the district in which the seat or position was vacated within ninety (90) days to elect a replacement for the remainder of the term unless said term shall expire ninety (90) days or less then in which case the successful candidate will be elected for a normal term of office. At the time of qualifying any candidate for a a Board of County Commissioners seat or position must have resided only within that district for not less than the preceding six (6) months to be eligible to qualify as a candidate.

Motion No.2

That the number of Clay County Board of Commissioner be changed from five (5) elected at large to Seven (7); with five (5) being elected only by the voters of the district they qualified for and two (2) being elected at large by the county wide electorate. That if the revision be approved by the voters then the amendment to the charter would become effective on January 1, following the general election. Further be it provided that commissioner for odd numbered districts be elected on odd number years and those with even number be elected on even number year elections. Further, that commissioners serving in office upon approval of this amendment shall continue to serve as a the duly elected Commissioner for the district position or seat held until the normal expiration of their term.

Motion No.3

That the constitutional officers of Clay County Florida, Charter form of government be limited to two (2) consecutive terms of office.

Further, that the above proposals be given attorney to be designated by the Charter Review Commission to be drafted in appropriate language and in accordance with applicable Florida Sta-

tutes. Said draft to be delivered by registered mail to each of the Charter Commission members by registered mail no later than two (2) weeks before March 1, 1994 or the first public hearing on the charter revisions whichever date may be earlier.
