

ATTENTION CLAY COUNTY RESIDENTS- GARBAGE COLLECTION CHANGES

GARBAGE

Place all garbage in 40-gallon trash cans with tight fitting lids, or heavy-duty plastic trash bags. Non containerized garbage excluding bulky waste will not be collected. No can or bag may exceed 50 lbs.

YARD WASTE

Place all leaves, grass clippings and small yard debris in a 40-gallon can or heavy-duty plastic trash bag for collection. Non containerized leaves, grass clippings and small yard debris will not be collected. No can or bag may exceed 50 lbs. All stumps, trees and limbs may not exceed 4 feet in length and 50 lbs in weight for a total of no more than 5 cubic yards per week.

RECYCLING

Place all recyclable materials in bins provided. Recyclable materials include the following: Newspaper and all inserts; #1 and 2 plastic beverage and soap containers (HDPE and PETE) all colors; Aluminum cans, steel cans, glass bottles and jars (green, clear and brown); Telephone books, magazines, office paper, junk mail and catalogs; Paperboard boxes broken down and corrugated cardboard boxes broken down. **DO NOT PLACE ANYTHING BUT RECYCLABLES IN THE RECYCLE BINS**

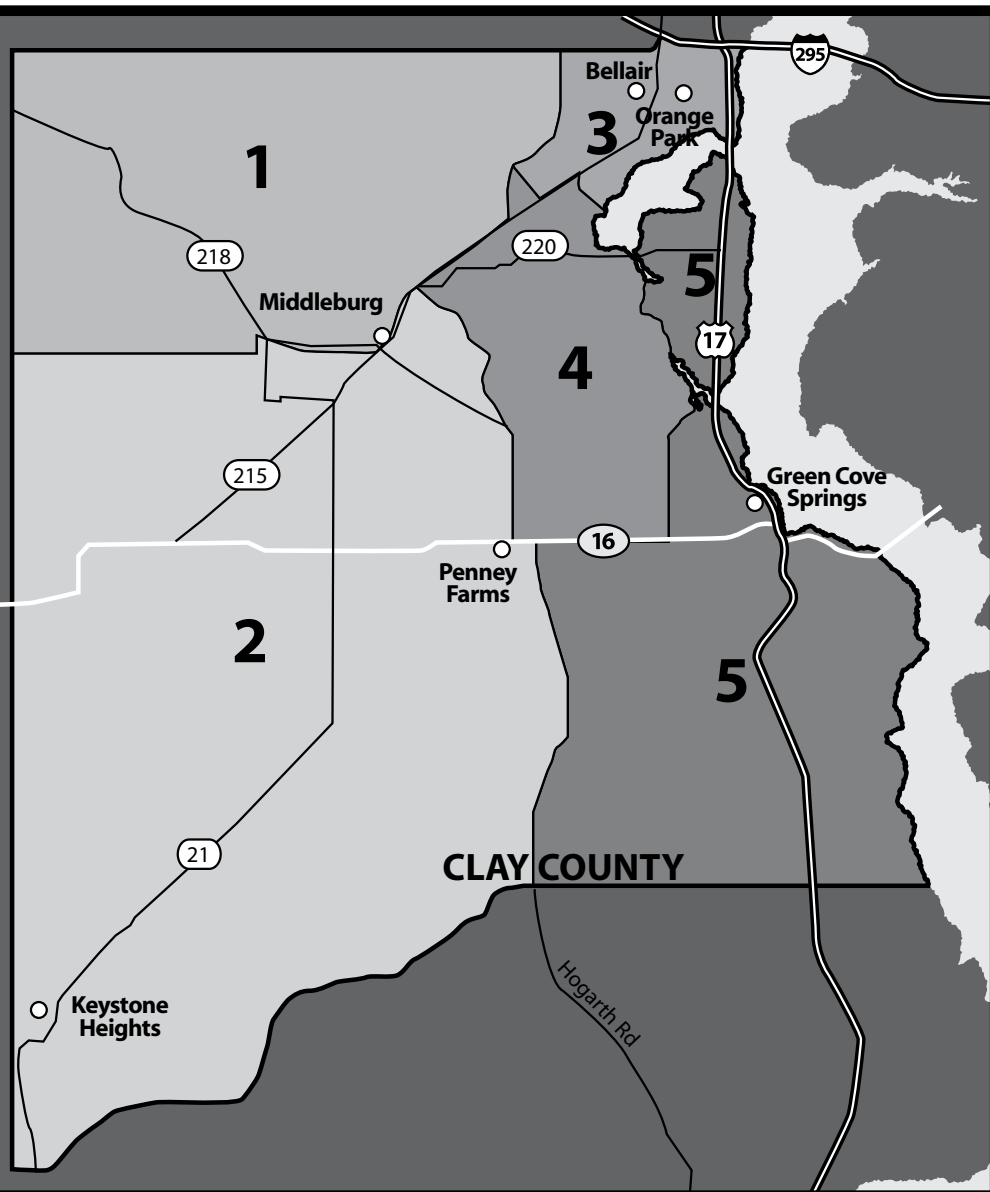
WHITE GOODS AND BULK ITEMS

All white goods(appliances) and bulk items will be picked

up one time per week. Please call in advance for a scheduled pickup. Bulk items include white goods, large household goods and furniture that were previously used by the customer at the dwelling for which collection service is provided.

ITEMS NOT TO BE PLACED CURBSIDE

Tires, batteries, automobile and boat parts, oils, paints, sludge, biological and hazardous waste. These items, except for sludge and biological waste may be taken to the Rosemary Hill Disposal Facility after some preparation; call The Environmental Services Department @ 904 269-6374 for details.



NOTE: Residents of the City of Orange Park, the City of Green Cove Springs, the City of Penney Farms and the City of Keystone Heights are not included in the Clay County service areas. The Cities are served separately from the unincorporated Areas and are not affected by these Service Changes.

Advanced Disposal Services will be providing waste services and recycling collection for every residence (single family, duplexes and triplexes) in Clay County starting Monday January 1, 2007. A post card has been sent to every residence during the week of 12/18/06 thru 12/22/06, letting them know what days we will be in their area. If you did not receive your post card you can call us at 1-866-779-CLAY(2529) to inquire as to the scheduled day of services. The map indicates the Zones of Clay County and the following chart identifies the days of service for garbage, yard waste and recycling by zone.

ZONE 1

Garbage on Monday
Yard Waste on Friday
Recycling on Friday

Generally includes Argyle, Oakleaf Plantation, Brannan Field, Old Jennings Rd west of SR21, CR 218 west of SR 21 and Clay Hill.

ZONE 2

Garbage on Tuesday
Yard Waste on Monday
Recycling on Monday

Generally includes Middleburg south of CR 218, SR 21 south of CR 218, SR 16 west of Penney Farms and all of Keystone Heights.

ZONE 3

Garbage on Wednesday
Yard Waste on Tuesday
Recycling on Tuesday

Generally includes Bellair East & West, Orange Park Country club, SR 21 up to Madison Ave. Doctors Inlet, Moody Road and Peoria.

ZONE 4

Garbage on Thursday
Yard Waste on Wednesday
Recycling on Wednesday

Generally includes SR 21 from Madison Ave. to CR 220, CR 220 from SR 21 to Swimming Pen Creek, Lake Asbury, CR 739, CR 209 to CR 315, and SR 16 east of Penney Farms to and including CR 315.

ZONE 5

Garbage on Friday
Yard Waste on Thursday
Recycling on Thursday

Generally includes Fleming Island, Eagle Harbor, all of US 17, CR 220 from US 17 to Swimming Pen Creek, SR 16 east of CR 315 and SR 15A, CR 209 south of CR315 and Green Cove Springs.
