

CLAY COUNTY
RESOLUTION # 2017/2018-13

WHEREAS, the following revenue generated from the 2-percent increase in Tourist Development Tax, per Ordinance No. 2017-31 and 2017-32 effective December 1, 2017, which is collected by the Clay County Tax Collector, was not budgeted in the fiscal year 2017/18 budget, and

WHEREAS, Section 129.06(2)(d) of the Florida Statutes stipulates that a receipt of a nature from a source not anticipated in the budget and received for a particular purpose may, by resolution of the Board, be appropriated and expended for that purpose, and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be allocated by the Clay County Tourist Development Council and approved by the Clay County Board of County Commissioners,

THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 129.06(2)(d) of the Florida Statutes, let it be resolved that the following budget be adopted.
