**WHEREAS**, the following revenue from Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, for the Derelict Vessel Removal Grant, was not budgeted in the approved fiscal year 2017-2018 Budget, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 129.06(2)(d) of the Florida Statutes stipulates that a receipt of a nature from a source not anticipated in the budget and received for a particular purpose may, by resolution of the Board, be appropriated and expended for that purpose, and

**WHEREAS**, the Clay County Board of County Commissioners will use these funds to remove two derelict vessels from the public waters of the State within the jurisdiction of Clay County, Florida,

**THEREFORE**, pursuant to Section 129.06(2)(d) of the Florida Statutes, let it be resolved that the following budget be adopted.


