

RESOLUTION #2017/2018-75

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CLAY COUNTY (INCLUDING SPECIAL TAXING DISTRICTS AND DEPENDENT TAXING DISTRICTS IN CLAY COUNTY) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida, on September 11, 2018, adopted Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Tentative Millage rates following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Board of County Commissioners as \$10,642,384,756.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida, that:

The Fiscal Year 2018-2019 proposed aggregate millage rate is 7.8505 which is more than the current year aggregate rolled-back rate of 7.4594 by 5.24%.

The proposed operating millage rates are broken down as follows:

County Services	5.2349 mills
Unincorporated Services MSTU Fund	0.1110 mills
Law Enforcement MSTU-4 Fund	2.2503 mills
Fire Control MSTU-8 Fund	0.5048 mills
Lake Asbury MSBD	0.0000 mills
Challenger Center MSTU	3.0000 mills

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
