WHEREAS, the following revenue from Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, for the Derelict Vessel Removal Grant, was not anticipate when the 2018-2019 budget was approved, and

WHEREAS, Section 129.06(2)(d) of the Florida Statutes stipulates that a receipt of a nature from a source not anticipated in the budget and received for a particular purpose may, by resolution of the Board, be appropriated and expended for that purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Clay County Board of County Commissioners will use these funds to remove derelict vessel(s) from the public waters of the State within the jurisdiction of Clay County, Florida, and agrees to match the State grant 25% utilizing Florida Boater Improvement funds, and

THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 129.06(2)(d) of the Florida Statutes, let it be resolved that the following budget be adopted.
