COVID-19 Testing Sites for Clay County

Five free drive through testing sites have been established for Clay County residents.

You must have an appointment and remain in your vehicle. No signs or symptoms are required.

Call the EOC Call Center to schedule an appointment 877-252-9362. Appointments will be made every 10 minutes from 8 a.m. – noon, weather permitting.

A COVID-19 Testing form is located at Alert.ClayCountyGov.com. Print and fill out the highlighted section of the form and bring it with you at your scheduled time. Forms will also be available on site.
